A huge congratulations to all staff and students involved in Open Evening which took place on Thursday 25 September. We had 94 families and over 250 people who attend our school and feedback from our parents' questionnaires was overwhelmingly positive and I am so grateful to all the staff an students who supported the event.

Our students are our best ambassadors!

We had 132 Stafford Manor High School students who attended our Open Evening to support activities and to lead tours for families. The feedback we have received about our students is exceptionally positive and they have all been rewarded with 20 achievement points for giving up their time and for modelling the 4Rs so expertly well and for their roles in making the event so successful. I am so proud of all our students for their conduct on the evening and just how well they portrayed our wonderful school and so should they and their parents be proud too.

I was particularly proud of the two Year 7 students Rose Kour and Jason Negru who read their Year 7 writing competition winning entries out to parents and Year 6 students on the night. They captured the main hall exceptionally well and I was so impressed with their performances and just how unphased they were about speaking in front of 200+ people. Rose and Jason have been rewarded with 20 ClassCharts points and a £10 amazon voucher for their excellent work.




Class Charts - Behaviour and Achievement system
