Impact in English

- 93% of students who entered Stafford Manor High School below a Level 4 in English have made expected progress over the academic year.

Impact in Maths

- 87% of students who entered Stafford Manor High School below a Level 4 in English have made expected progress over the academic year.

Impact on reading ability

- 45% of students reading below their chronological age on entry to Stafford Manor High school.
- From a targeted reading group of 23 students, 17 improved their reading age over the academic year (74%)

All students are continually assessed through KS3 for reading and arithmetic and where their ability effects their chance of accessing the curriculum, extra interventions are provided for these students.
