Summary of CUF Spending

Main Objective: To give students the best possible chance of making expected or better than expected progress in English, Maths and reading.

Impact in English

- 100% of students who entered Stafford Manor High School below a Level 4 in English have made progress over the academic year, 83% making expected or more than expected progress.
- 67% of students in this cohort are working at Level 4 or above at the end of the academic year.

Impact in Maths

- 100% of students who entered Stafford Manor High School below a Level 4 in maths have made progress over the academic year.
- 67% of students in this cohort are working at Level 4 or above at the end of the academic year. A further 2 students are only 1 sub-level away from a Level 4 (82% of the catch-up cohort).

Impact on reading ability

- 31 students were a concern from their reading tests on entry in September. 16 of these students improved to reading above their chronological age by the end of the academic year (52% of group).
- 9 of the remaining 15 students improved their reading age by more than 12 months.
