Impact in English

- 88% of students who entered Stafford Sports College below a level 4 in English achieve a level 4 by the end of Year 7. 100% of the students achieved a level 3 or above.
- Every student who entered Stafford Sports College below a level 4 in English has improved their English level by at least 1 sub level (1 grade = 3 sub levels). Every student who entered the school below a level 4 in English are on track to achieve, on average, 3.6 sub levels progress by the end of Year 8.

Impact in Maths

- Every student who entered Stafford Sports College below a level 4 in Maths are on track to achieve, on average, 3.3 sub levels progress by the end of Year 8.
- 29% of students who entered Stafford Sports College below a level 4 in Maths are on track to make 2 levels progress by the end of Year 8.

Impact on reading ability

- Catch up funded students made an average of 25 months reading age progress in a 12 month period.
