Year	Content of the Curriculum	Additional Resources to aid Learning e.g. web links, guided reading
7	<p>Cakes - Looking at Artists such as Joel Penkham and Sarah Graham, pupils work on their drawing skills, including the Formal Elements and understand how artists link with their projects.</p> <p>Insects – Looking at artists such as Helen Ahpornisiri and Mark Oliver, pupils work on more 3D based drawing skills including Mixed Media work and 3D sculpture work.</p> <p>Fruit – Looking at artists such as Elizabeth St.Hilaire, pupils understand the meaning of ‘Surface Pattern’ and how to create paper mache 3D sculptures.</p>	
8	<p>Pop Art – Looking at artists such as Roy Lichtenstein, pupils are practising their drawing skills and using techniques such as pointillism. Pupils base some drawings on chocolate and hobbies. We then link in artists.</p> <p>Indian Art – Looking at artists such as Cate Parr and Marcia Baldwin, pupils are to understand how to use watercolours in the style of Cate Parr.</p> <p>Day of the Dead – This is a small project that is based on Multi-culture within Art & Design.</p>	
9	<p>Marine Life – Looking at artists such as Vincent Scarpace, Tom Hill, Helen Musselwhite and Healy & Burke. This is a large project where pupils are introduced to more techniques ready for GCSE Art. Pupils do mixed media drawings, wire work, paper manipulation, felt making and making plastic bottle jellyfish.</p> <p>Mock GCSE project – Pupils do a small GCSE project based on Sweets.</p>	
10	<p>AQA GCSE Art & Design</p> <p>Workshops – Pupils work on different workshops to build up their knowledge, understanding & skills.</p> <p>Theme - Pupils receive a theme that we work on. This will be one project. Once the project is finished, we start a new theme.
